Dear brothers and sisters,

“The LORD was pleased to crush him in infirmity [...] through his suffering, my servant shall justify many, and their guilt he shall bear.” That is how the first reading of the prophet Isaiah describes the fate of the Messiah. After reading this it reminded me of the last years of Pope St. John Paul II; it comes to my mind how physically challenging became things for him and how hard it was to speak. He had to relearn to speak using another part of his brain. On Monday we celebrate his feast day in the Church and I think we have so much to learn from that great saint. I had the chance to be with him at least twice and it was impressive to be in his presence — specially because of his simplicity and love. He taught us not only how to be a Christian when we are young and strong but also how to age and deal with the limitations that appear. I think we need to learn that from him, that aging and getting limited is also a gift from God...

St. Francis of Assisi said that before meeting God again, three sisters had to come to prepare us: old age, sickness and death. Let us ask St. John Paul II that he may intercede for us, and that we may have his Joyfulness and also his Patience.

In other news, today the Rosarians have their rededication and induction mass — Congratulations to all of them and thanks for all you do! Also, the Knights of Columbus are here to invite the men of the parish to join them. I strongly encourage every man to join and be part of the Knights. In other topic, we had our first Youth Group Night and it was wonderful — please pray for our Youth Group. Further, we had the Listening Session and are waiting for the Diocese to send us the compilation of all the discussion. Finally, we are going to have our first Casino Night... I invite you all to participate and enjoy this night together as a parish.


