Solar Panel Review Requirements

- 1. What is the approximate turnaround time to obtain permits once everything is submitted?
 - The initial review will be completed in approximately 9 business days. Any subsequent reviews will be conducted within 5 business days.
- 2. Do you have a Fee Schedule, or can you provide us with the cost to obtain necessary permits? What form of payment is acceptable and how must it be submitted?
 - Permit fee is \$422.50 which includes plan review, inspections, and admin fee. Cash or Check only made to The Village of Lily Lake; can be submitted with the application.
- 3. May we submit applications via email, or do you require in person submission?
 - If the plans are no larger than 11x17, they may be submitted electronically. Larger sized documents must be submitted in hard copy format.
- 4. Do you require Fire, Utility or HOA approval?
 - There are no separate reviews required by the Village of Lily Lake. If there is an HOA, that is the owner's responsibility to comply with.
- 5. Do you require engineering calculations, and if so, how many?
 - Documentation from an Illinois Licensed Architect or Structural engineer required for the loading calculations based on existing construction and code requirements. This may be a letter or drawings or combination of.
- 6. How many sets of plans do you require and are 11x17 sufficient?
 - Three sets are required. Yes 11x17 are sufficient as long as they are to scale.
- 7. Do you require an electrical or structural stamp, or an engineering letter?
 - See previous comment for structural. If the electrical documents are created by a licensed individual, they shall be stamped by an Illinois Licensed Design Professional. If the documents are not prepared by a design professional, they do not need to be stamped but do need to contain all proper information.
- 8. Are there any City/State Codes or other specific requirements?
 - We require that you follow at least the 2015 international Residential Code as well as the 2014 National Electrical Code. Anything newer is acceptable as well.
