

## MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, July 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020, at the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with all councillors present and Division 1 vacant.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020 were approved as circulated. The Statement of Financial Activities for the month of June was accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council awarded bursaries to Danielle Annetts and Simon Berry, authorized a road improvement project at the intersection of Twp Rd 61 and Rge Rd 1322, and authorized the municipality to apply under the RIRG Stimulus Funding for the Twp Rd 60 upgrade project. Council acknowledged receipt of the January to June indemnity statements and authorized payment as submitted. Council approved a ratepayer request for installation of 2, Slow Watch for Children signs in front of their residence, and set the time for the August regular council meeting for 7:00 am.

One delegation was received – a contractor.

Public Works Foreman, White, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop operation.

A number of road right-of-way applications were approved.

Correspondence was received and filed.
