Debts in divorce

QUESTION:

1. Can I exclude a debt awarded to an ex-spouse assigned in a divorce decree/legal separation document?

ANSWER:

You are good to exclude debts assigned in a divorce decree.

(iii) Assigned debt

A liability on a secured debt, including a Mortgage, may be excluded from the monthly debt payment-toincome ratio if the obligation to make the payments on a debt of the Borrower:

- Has been assigned to another by court order, such as a divorce decree, and
- The Seller documents the order (e.g., provides appropriate pages from the separation agreement or divorce decree)
