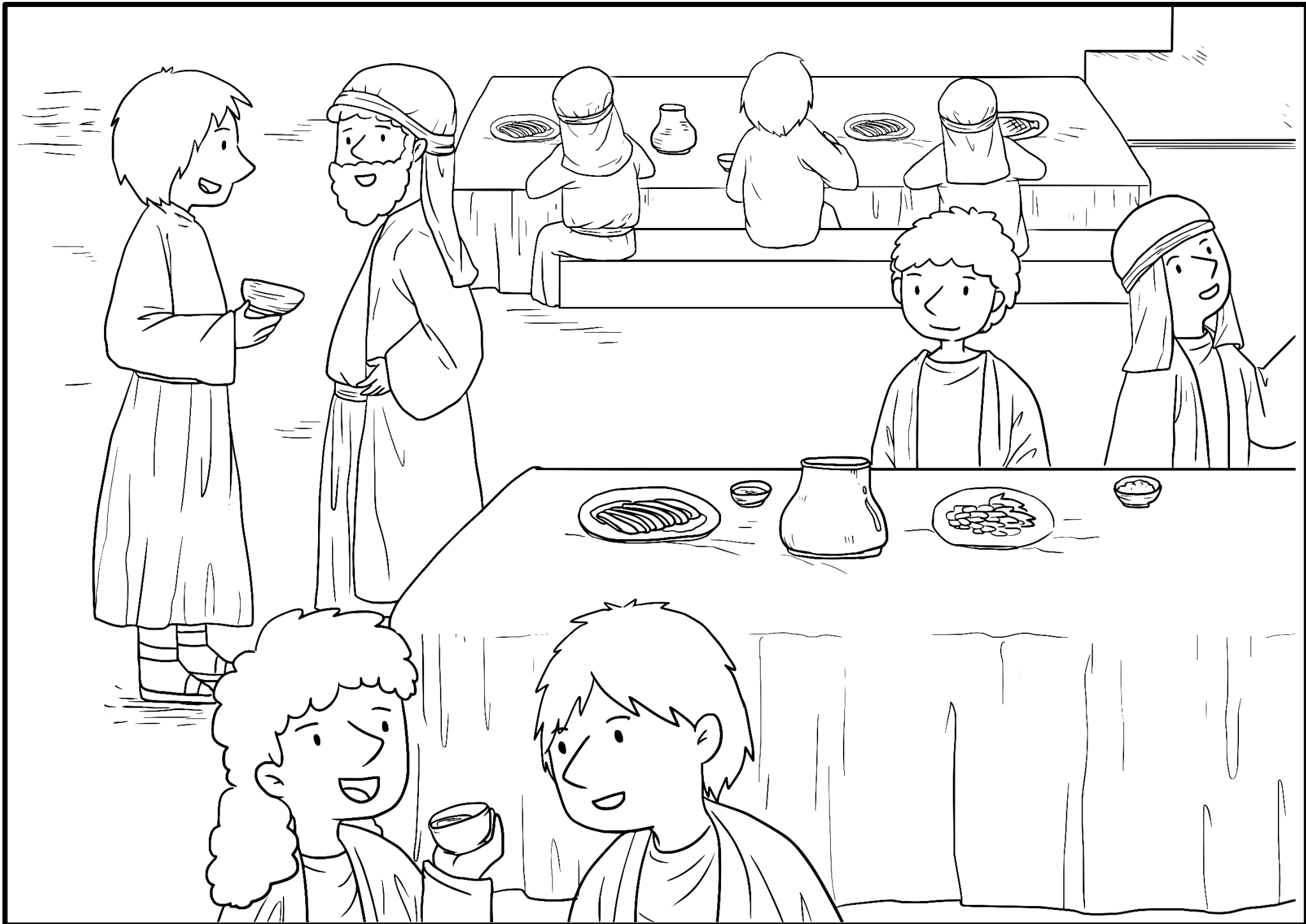

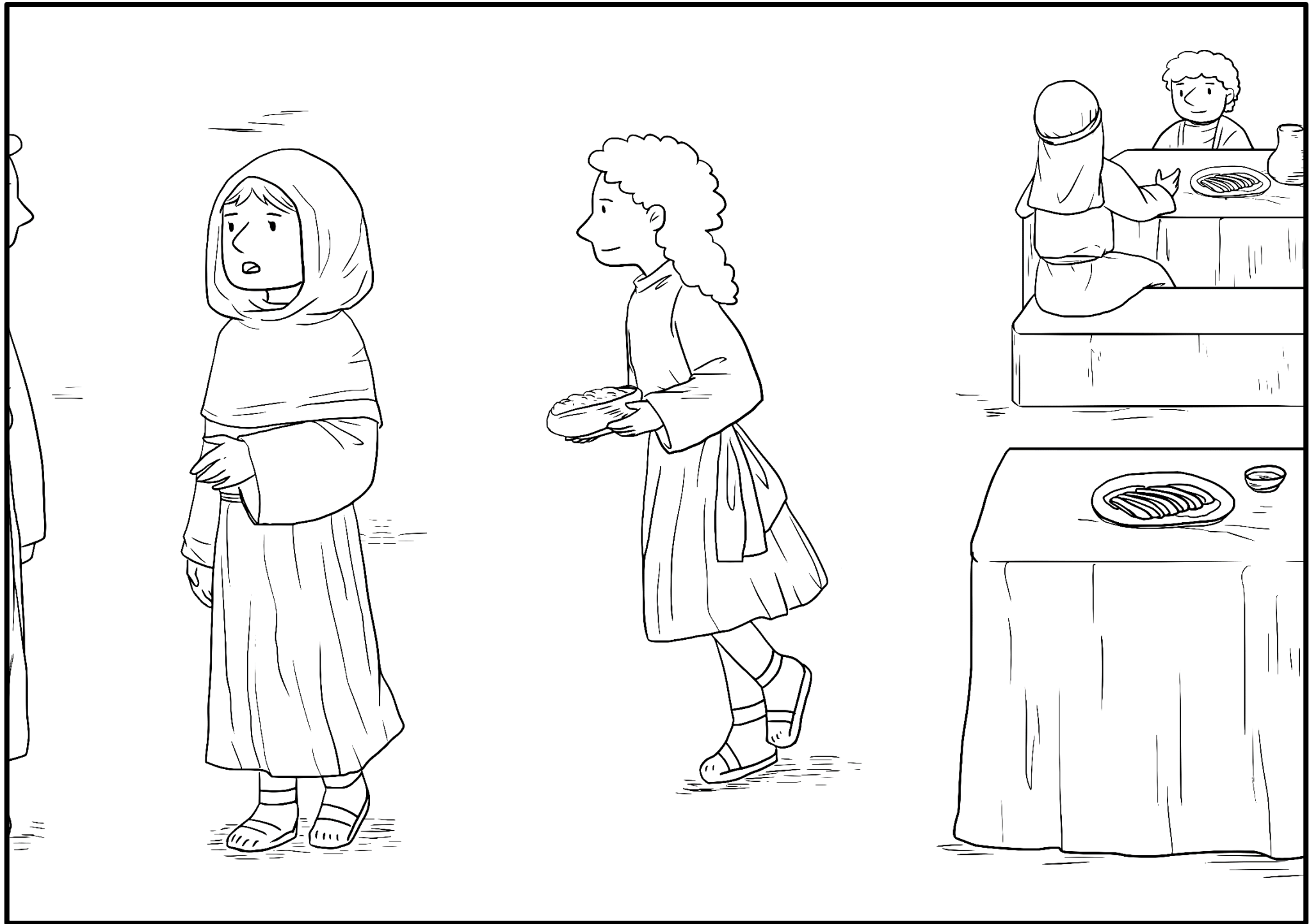
Water Into



wine



And on the third day a marriage took place in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Yahshua was there. And Yahshua and His disciples also were invited to the marriage – John 2:1-2



And being short of wine, the mother of Yahshua said to Him, they have no wine. Yahshua said to her, what do you want from Me to you, woman? My hour has not yet come - John 2:3-4



And there were six stone water pots standing, according to the purification of the Jews, each containing two or three measures. Yahshua said to them, fill the water pots with water. And they filled them to the top – John 2:6-7



But when the master of the feast tasted the water that had become wine, and did not know from where it was (but the servants drawing the water knew), the master of the feast called the bridegroom, and he said to him, every man first sets on the good wine, and when they have drunk freely, then the inferior one. You have kept the good wine until now – John 2:9-10
